Julien Taïeb, MD, PhD, received his MD and PhD qualifications from the Université Pierre et Marie Curie (Paris VI) in Paris, France, after completing a Bachelor of Science degree. He currently holds the position of head of the Gastroenterology and Gastrointestinal Oncology Department at the Georges Pompidou European Hospital, Sorbonne Paris Cité, Université Paris Descartes, in Paris, France.

Professor Taïeb is a regular reviewer for *Lancet Oncology*, *Journal of Clinical Oncology*, *Annals of Oncology*, and the *European Journal of Cancer*.

He is a member of the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO), the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO), and a number of French gastrointestinal cooperative groups and societies, including the PRODIGE intergroup, the Fédération Francophone de Cancérologie Digestive (FFCD), the Groupe Cooperateur Multidisciplinaire en Oncologie (GERCOR), and the Société Nationale Française de Gastro-Entérologie (SNFGE). He has positions in the administrative council and the scientific committees of ESMO, FFCD, and SNFGE and in the ESMO nomination committee.

He is involved in the redaction of many French and European guidelines on GI cancers.

Prof Taïeb's main current research topics are non-metastatic and metastatic colorectal cancer and pancreatic cancer. He has led more than 10 phase III and 20 phase I-II trials and has published a lot of translational research articles derived from these trials.

He has authored 3 educational books, more than 200 peer-reviewed publications, and 500 meeting abstracts.
